

PROXIBID LISTING POLICY

In order to provide assurance to our bidders about the professionalism, standards, and common practice of our clients, Proxibid requires all clients to meet one or more of the following requirements:

- Have a valid auctioneer or auction firm license from an offering state or province.
- Have an employee or staff member who holds a valid auctioneer license.
- For businesses located in a state or province that does not issue or require an auction license:
 - a. Graduate from one of the National Auctioneer Association (NAA) [approved auctioneer schools](#),
or
 - b. Hold a membership in a state, provincial or national auctioneer association **AND** conduct live auction events.

[New Entrants] Additional Requirements:

- Complete a Conflict of Interests form that outlines any working relationships with current Proxibid clients in the last 24 months.
- Maintain an active website with a dedicated auction listing page.

We expect all of our clients to operate in accordance with licensing requirements and applicable state and federal laws. We recognize under some unique circumstances an auction house may not be able to meet these criteria. In those circumstances we will work to certify auction houses that have a proven and undisputed track record operating as an auction house. In addition, we reserve the right to reject any application at our own discretion.
